Several factors increase a bill's chance of becoming law: authored by legislators in the majority party (Democrats control the House and Republicans control the Senate) and having a companion bill (a version in both the House and Senate). Bills written by the chairs of the education committees have a very high chance of making progress (Davnice (finance) and Youakim(policy) in the House and Nelson in the Senate). Bills not heard in committee tend to die. Most bills heard in committee are laid on the table for possible inclusion in an omnibus bill, which is a large bill containing many different individual bills.
