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Several factors that increase a bill's chance of becoming law include bill authored by legislators in the majority party (Democrats control the House and Republicans control the Senate) and having a companion bill (a version in both the House and Senate). Bills written by the chairs of the education committees have a very high chance of making progress (Davnier (finance) and Richardson (policy) in the House and Chamberlain in the Senate). All bills referred to education committees unless noted otherwise. Bills not heard in committee tend to die.
